The first person known to have reached Bermuda was the Spanish sea captain Juan de Bermúdez in 1503, after whom the islands are named. He claimed the islands for the Spanish Empire.

The island experienced large-scale immigration over the 20th century, especially after the Second World War. Bermuda has a diverse population including both those with relatively deep roots in Bermuda extending back for centuries, and newer communities whose ancestry results from recent immigration, especially from Britain, North America, the West Indies, and the Portuguese Atlantic islands

Because of its limited land area, Bermuda has had difficulty with over-population.

Bermuda's culture is a mixture of the various sources of its population: Native American, Spanish-Caribbean, English, Irish, and Scots cultures were evident in the 17th century, and became part of the dominant British culture. English is the primary and official language. Due to 160 years of immigration from Portuguese Atlantic islands, a portion of the population also speaks Portuguese. There are strong British influences, together with Afro-Caribbean ones.

Bermuda's pink sand beaches and clear, cerulean blue ocean waters are popular with tourists. In the early 20th century, as modern transport and communication systems developed, Bermuda became a popular destination for American, Canadian and British tourists arriving by sea. Having no corporate income tax, Bermuda is a popular tax avoidance location.

Majority of the population of Bermuda practices Christianity. In the last decades, there has been a significant shift in the Bermudians faith from old guard religious sects to the more charismatic evangelical churches. Church congregations in Bermuda are also quite active especially in communities. Because of this, church leaders have strong influences and roles in the Bermudian culture.
