9th Hour Prayer Initiative

Sunday, 9 June (Pentecost)-29 September 2019 (Rosh Hashanah)

Praying Daily for the Salvation, Strength, Security of Israel and Global Harvest

"Do you not say, 'There are yet four months, and then comes the harvest?'

Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look on the fields,

that they are white for harvest," John 4:35.

God speaking to Noah: "And as for Me, behold, I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you." Gen 9:9

We are entering into a significant time spiritually. Coming to the end of the 70 year anniversary of Israel's statehood, escalation of assault on Israel is emerging. Tensions are on the rise in the Middle East as are overt attacks on Israel. This initiative is a call to action! Though threats loom, this is not the time for escalation, but rather for salvation. Why? Isaiah 60:10 says, "The sons of foreigners shall build up your walls!" It is an hour when God is calling forth the spiritual walls of Jerusalem to rise up! We are in a significant window of time to build intentionality and focus towards ongoing strategic prayer for Israel.

How do we respond? While preparing for a journey to Israel recently, the Lord spoke through a vision of a dark place in which a narrow doorway opened. Sensing the Lord say, "The gate is narrow, enter by it," we believe we are in a "narrow window" of time and opportunity to pray more intentionally for the salvation of Israel, Egypt, and Assyria (Isaiah 19:25) and the harvest globally. This is a time of preparation to build and strengthen for the times ahead.

Prayer during the 9th hour, 3pm, is highly strategic scripturally and the signs are pointing to this important intervention now. The 9th hour is significant scripturally:

- **Salvation**: It was the hour when Jesus died and the veil was rent in the temple. Mt 27:51.
- **Healing:** It was the hour when Peter and John performed the first healing after Pentecost. Acts 3:1-10.
- **Kingdom advance:** It was the hour the angel appeared to Cornelius and said, "Your prayer has been heard, and your alms are remembered in the sight of God," Acts 10:31.

As you are aware, we are also in the year 5779, 2019, both ending the year 9. As 9 represents the time the veil was rent in the temple, the parallel is happening in the eyes of unbelievers. The blindness is being removed as Romans 11:25 promises, "That blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in." The time of harvest is upon us.

Introduction



The 9th hour is being highlighted as God moves across the face of the earth to awaken His bride. Watchmen are being alerted to the import of this hour accentuated in the scriptures. The 9th hour is 3pm, the time Jesus died on the cross and the veil was forever rent offering all access to Him, Mt. 27:46-51. It is the hour Peter and John performed the first miracle after Pentecost, Acts 3:1. It

is also the hour the angel appeared to Cornelius and told him his prayers had been heard in heaven and instructions were given as to how to fulfill them, Acts 10:31.

In Jewish tradition, there were regular hours of prayer inferred from the following:

- Ps 55:17 "Evening, morning, and noon I cry out in distress and He hears my voice."
- Daniel 6:10 "Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God as he had done before."

The first hour of prayer coincided with the morning sacrifice 9am, the second was the sixth hour, or at noon, the third hour was at 3pm.

Understanding God's covenant with Israel

In times of increasing stress and distress in personal lives and in and between nations, it is important to understand God's covenant with Israel. It is His ultimate peace plan. Otherwise, we can get tossed to and fro wondering why all the concern over Israel and what about my country, my city, my life in which problems are seemingly out of control. God's plans are to prosper and not harm us (Jer 29:11). Through Israel, God has revealed His plan to ultimately bring all things into order under His feet. It is a promise...a covenant. A covenant is an agreement, or contract between two or more parties. In the Bible, however, covenants take on a commitment like a treaty with no negotiation of terms allowed. God is the author and people had/have the choice to accept or decline it. Foundational to this understanding is that the author is God the creator, and we are His creation. Our well-being is dependent on His love. One of the most important covenants God made was with the Israelites. The Lord said to Abram:

• "Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you. I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." Gen 12:1-3

From this statement, God promised that His purpose and plan for salvation, protection, provision, and blessing would center and filter through Israel. Paul says in Romans 9:4-5, "They are Israelites, to whom pertain the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service of God, and the promises; of whom are the fathers and from whom, according to the flesh, Christ came, who is over all, the eternally blessed God."

God does not revoke His covenant. His covenant is not with the words of the law, but with the people. As centuries have passed since Christ's birth, death, and resurrection, the covenant is still there. It is His promise and He does not break it...we do. Disobedience is not His choice, it is ours. Disobedience to God's covenant was Israel's choice. They disobeyed. Through disobedience to the law, God continued to fulfill His part as Creator by adding a new dimension to the covenant through the "New Covenant," through Jesus Christ, an Israelite. This new covenant is spoken in Jesus' own words:

- "And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said: 'Take, eat; this is My body.' Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, 'Drink from it, all of you. For this is My blood of the *new covenant*, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom,'" Mt. 26:29
- "And for this reason He is the Mediator of the **new covenant**, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance." Heb 9:15

Jesus paved the way for all, Jew and Gentile, to enter into the blessing God has for those who believe. Throughout history, Israel and Jerusalem are and will be the center-fold of God's end-time plan. As such, praying for Israel in these escalating times aligns us with God's heart and His plans and purposes for all nations, tribes and tongues.

• "After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" Rev 7:9

Strategic prayer for Israel aligns us with the purposes and plans of God as His end-time plan unfolds.

Salvation and Global Harvest


Pray for repentance for eyes to see and hearts to desire to know Jesus:


• "I have not come to call righteous people, but sinners, to repentance." Luke 5:32

Prayer for the global harvest:

Sending and Strengthening of the Laborers

Prayer for the call of God to be heard and people respond:

- "Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. "Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest." Mt.9:37-38
- "For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable." Rom 11:29



- "Those who sow in tears shall reap with joyful shouting. He who goes to and fro weeping, carrying his bag of seed, Shall indeed come again with a shout of joy, bringing his sheaves with him." Ps 126:5-6
- "Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe Come, tread, for the wine press is full; The vats overflow, for their wickedness is great." Joel 3:13
- "Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary." Gal 6:9

For the fullness of the Gentile Church:

- "For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. And so all Israel will be saved." Rev. 11:25-26
- "For as many as are led by then Spirit of God, these are sons of God.
- "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ." Eph 4:11-13
- "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him. In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will, that we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory." Eph 1:7-12

Security of Israel

• "If it had not been the Lord who was on our side," Let Israel now say—"If it had not

been the Lord who was on our side, When men rose up against us, Then they would have swallowed us alive, When their wrath was kindled against us; Then the waters would have overwhelmed us, The stream would have gone over our soul; Then the swollen water Would have gone over our soul." Blessed be the Lord, Who has not given us as prey to their teeth. Our soul has escaped as a bird from the snare of the fowlers; The snare is broken, and we have escaped. Our help is in the name of the Lord Who made heaven and earth." Ps 124



• "Those who trust in the Lord Are like Mount Zion, Which cannot be moved, but abides forever. As the mountains surround Jerusalem, So the Lord surrounds His people From this time forth and forever. For the scepter of wickedness shall not rest On the land

- allotted to the righteous, Lest the righteous reach out their hands to iniquity. Do good, O Lord, to those who are good, And to those who are upright in their hearts. As for such as turn aside to their crooked ways, The Lord shall lead them away With the workers of iniquity. Peace be upon Israel!" Ps 125
- "The Lord shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore." Ps 121:7-8
- "Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; but you shall call your walls Salvation, and your gates Praise." Is 60:18
- ""I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; They shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them. I will plant them in their land, And no longer shall they be pulled up From the land I have given them," Says the Lord your God." Amos 9:14-15

Our faith in this initiative:

- **Ignite and strengthen a global awakening** to pray for Israel, and global harvest with intentionality and commitment.
 - Oh, that the salvation of Israel would come out of Zion! When the LORD restores His captive people, Jacob will rejoice, Israel will be glad. Ps 14:7
 - Jesus said, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet that was cast into the sea and gathered some of every kind, which, when it was full, they drew to shore; and they sat down and gathered the good into vessels, but threw the bad away. So it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come forth, separate the wicked from among the just, and cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth." Mt. 13:47-50
- Build up the spiritual walls of Jerusalem in the nations by uniting in prayer and strategy,
 - "I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day or night. You who make mention of the Lord, do not keep silent and give Him no rest till He establishes and till He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth." Is 62:6-7
 - "Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." 1 Peter 2:4-5
- **Inspire revelation, spiritual discipline, and connections** for ongoing prayer for Israel in preparation for the times ahead.
 - "Your watchmen shall lift up their voices, with their voices they shall sing together; for they shall see eye to eye when the Lord brings back Zion." Is 52:8

More "9" highlights in scripture:

- **Genesis 9:9** God speaking to Noah: "And as for Me, behold, I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you."
- Matthew 9:9: "As Jesus went on from there, He saw a man called Matthew, sitting in the tax collector's booth; and He said to him, "Follow Me!" And he got up and followed Him."
- **Mark 9:9:** "As they were coming down from the mountain, He gave them orders not to relate to anyone what they had seen, until the Son of Man rose from the dead."
- Luke 9:9 "Herod said, "I myself had John beheaded; but who is this man about whom I hear such things?" And he kept trying to see Him."
- **John 9:9** "Others were saying, '*This is he,'* still others were saying, '*No, but he is like him.*' He kept saying, '*I am the one.*'"

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
