



Psalm 126 (AMP)

When the LORD brought back the captives to Zion we were like those who dream it seemed so unreal. Then our mouth was filled with laughter and our tongue with joyful shouting; then they said among the nations, "The LORD has done great things for them."

The LORD has done great things for us; we are glad! Restore our captivity, O LORD, as the stream-beds in the South (the Negev) are restored by torrents of rain.

They who sow in tears shall reap with joyful singing. He who goes back and forth weeping, carrying his bag of seed for planting, will indeed come again with a shout of joy, bringing his sheaves with him.

This is a psalm of restoration and joy! As we continue to prepare our hearts for our time in Herrnhut, let us remember and honour those who laboured before us. Let us also rejoice with the great cloud of witnesses and press in, entering into their labours and reaping where we have not sown. (John 4:38, 1 Cor 3:7-9, John 4:35-36)

Suggested Prayer Focuses:

- **Amos 9:13** "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "When the plowman will overtake the reaper And the treader of grapes him who sows seed... This scripture speaks of fruitfulness, abundance, acceleration, bypassing even the normal laws of nature resulting in a miraculous harvest. **Ask the Lord to release the blessing of this promise resulting in a BIGGER and FASTER harvest than we have ever seen in history. Ask Him to prepare us, and His church worldwide, for this season as we are pressed into action. The joy of the Lord shall be our strength!**
- **Joel 2:23** *Be glad, people of Zion, rejoice in the LORD your God, for he has given you the autumn rains because he is faithful. He sends you abundant showers, both autumn and spring rains, as before. Rejoice in the Lord! Look to Him as the Faithful One and the One who refreshes and revives us!*
- **Hosea 6:3** *"Let us acknowledge the LORD; let us press on to acknowledge him. As surely as the sun rises, he will appear; he will come to us like the winter rains, like the spring rains that water the earth."* **Press in to know the Lord in a deeper way; cry out for Him to revive His people worldwide!**
- **Haggai 2:9** *"The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house," says the LORD Almighty. 'And in this place I will grant peace,' declares the LORD Almighty. " **Cry out for the new wine, ask for eyes to see His glory and ears to hear His Spirit as He does a new thing in the earth. Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem.***

Prayer :

Lord, even as the farmer went away and he did not know how it happened (Mark 4:26-29) so are we amazed at what you are doing in this hour! Thank you that the seeds planted many years ago in Herrnhut, although hidden for a time, are now bringing forth fruit according to their kind. (Gen 1:11-12). Your word says in **Rev 14:15** *Thrust in the sickle, for the time has come to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe!* Lord, send labourers for the harvest; use us to restore age-old foundations and to repair all the breaches (Isaiah 58:12) Come and rebuild and restore David's fallen tent and all its ruins so that the remnant of men may seek You, and all the Gentiles who bear Your name (Acts 15:16-17). **We thank you that you are a God of restoration: of our lives, of our families, of our communities and of all the nations!** Revive your work O Lord as in days of old! (Hab 3:2) Amen.
