3 Mandates for the Watch: (ICE or I-CE (I see))

- Identity in Christ through intimacy with God "tend and keep"
- Cultivate a culture of prayer and community for ongoing and strategic breakthrough prayer
- Engage with cultural spheres for transformation and revival

Values of the Watch: Review Core Values

- Life giving community/collaboration/protocol of honor
- Habakkuk 2:1 central encouraging environments for people to experience God and hear from Him "Encounter" culture
- Connect through relationship and agreement to common core values

Night Watch

- Spiritual breaker for all this to happen
- Why the 4th watch
 - o God is doing it: join with what He is doing
 - Sets the order for the day
 - Job 38:12 "Have you commanded the morning since your days began, and caused the dawn to know its place."
 - Highly strategic
 - Thief comes to steal at night Luke 12:39
 - Virgins all asleep Mt. 25
 - Strategic events:
 - Passover: Exod 12:42, Deuteronomy 16:1 (NKJV)
 Observe the month of Abib, and keep the Passover to the Lord your God, for in the month of Abib the Lord your God brought you out of Egypt by night.
 - Moses leads the Israelits across the red sea Exodus 14;25-26
 - Gideon defeats Midianites, Judges 7:19-24
 - Jacob wrestles with God Genesis 32:22-31
 - Peter and Jesus walk on water, Mt. 14:25-26
 - Jesus resurrected from the dead. Mt. 28:1
 - Bridegroom woes His bride in the night hours. Song of Solomon 3:1, Mt. 25:1-13
 - o Prophetic destiny for the USA October 12, 1565 Ft. Caroline,
 - Sustaining the night watch is critical for viable 24/7 release
