



### Psalm 120-121 - January 1 to 31

<sup>1</sup> I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from?

<sup>2</sup> My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.

<sup>3</sup> He will not let your foot slip—he who watches over you will not slumber;

<sup>4</sup> indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.

<sup>5</sup> The LORD watches over you— the LORD is your shade at your right hand;

<sup>6</sup> the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night.

<sup>7</sup> The LORD will keep you from all harm— he will watch over your life;

<sup>8</sup> the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

**Look up** to the One who is Life and gives life. Look up to Jehovah Elroi, the God who sees. Look up to Jehovah Immeke, The Lord who is with you. Look and see He watches over you. *selah*

**Cast** *“[throw] all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully].”*

#### **Suggested Prayer focuses**

Pray for revelation that God is watching over you. His eyes ranging throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him. 2 Chronicles 16:9,

As you prepare for the gathering in Herrnhut, ask the Lord for His word to strengthen you emotionally, physically and spiritually. Ephesians 1:3, 3:16-19, Isaiah 41:9-13

Ask God to watch over all your ways that we can offer ourselves holy and pleasing to God ready to be fitted together to be a holy priesthood ministering to Him and one another as we gather in His name. Romans 12:1, 1 Peter 1:16, 2:5, Ephesians 1:4, Psalm 141:3

Pray God’s love and promises over Israel. *“He who scattered Israel will gather them and will watch over his flock like a shepherd”* Jeremiah 31:10, Exodus 3:16, Deuteronomy 11:12, Ezra 5:5

### Step One: Psalm 120

In my distress I cried to the Lord, And He heard me. Deliver my soul, O Lord, from lying lips And from a deceitful tongue. What shall be given to you, Or what shall be done to you, You false tongue? Sharp arrows of the warrior, With coals of the broom tree! Woe is me, that I dwell in Meshech, That I dwell among the tents of Kedar! My soul has dwelt too long With one who hates peace. I am for peace; But when I speak, they are for war.

### Suggested Prayer Points:

- God would send those who are uniquely called to the mission and purpose of the meeting

- God would send and prepare those willing to pay the price of peacemakers (not peacekeepers) and willing to build collaboratively

  - Psalm 133

  - Isaiah 62:10
  - Isaiah 58:9-12
  - Isaiah 57:14-15
- Prepare people with words of encouragement;
  - Deuteronomy 30:19-20
  - Luke 6:45
  - Proverbs 18:21
