



Week 4- Psalm 18: 16-20

His Right Hand and His Holy Arm –Isaiah 57:15-16 (NIV) For this is what the high and exalted One says—he who lives forever, whose name is holy: “I live in a high and holy place, but also with the one who is contrite and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly and to revive the heart of the contrite. I will not accuse them forever, nor will I always be angry, for then they would faint away because of me—the very people I have created.
